RAINY DAY PROCEDURES

On rainy days, children will enter and exit from the designated areas of the school. When it is raining in the morning, students will wait in an orderly manner in the cafeteria. At the 8:10 bell grades Pre-K, K and 1^{st} , will go to their rooms, and at the 8:25 bell grades 2 – 8 will go to their rooms.

If at dismissal, the weather becomes a danger to the child, the school will not dismiss children until the situation clears. There will be a yellow flag on the flag pole indicating Rainy Day Procedures are in place. The parent must enter the building and pick up his/her child at their designated area.

Bus Transported Children
